John Patrick Quinton

John Patrick Quinton was born at Kilmore in 1883, the son of John and Mary Quniton (nee Geary). On enlistment John gave his occupation as farmer and he was living with his parents at Balldale, NSW.

John enlisted at Melbourne on January 24, 1916 and was assessed as fit on the same day. He was allocated to the Reserve Company, 4th Depot Battalion, Seymour, as a private. On February 17, 1916 John was transferred to A Company, 37th Battalion and allocated his service number V18499.

John was medically reassessed on July 11 at Seymour and declared medically unfit due to lumbago and internal haemorrhoids. He was discharged on July 26.

John married Selina M Petersen in 1927 at Corowa, NSW and died at Wangaratta, Victoria in 1951.
